5. What are some things you'd have to change in your life in order to prioritize making disciples of Jesus through evangelism and invitation? What's the best/worst that could happen if you lived on mission?
6. How do you feel about Millennials? What are some things Millennials value? How could you adapt your attitudes and your approach in order to have a greater Gospel impact on this generation?
7. What are some things we may need to change as a Church in order to reach more neighborhoods with the Gospel? What are some things you could change personally to see more parts of the city reached for Jesus?
