Gospel Applications: Worry + Worship amidst COVID-19

- 2. What are some basic things people would like to know about the future right now even one week, one month, or three months out? What would you most want to know?
- 3. How are some of the things you listed under #1-2 under assault right now?
- 4. Do you tend to worry more about the essentials of life (food, drink, clothing, shelter) or non-essentials that you've simply grown accustomed to? Why?
- 5. What are you most anxious about right now? How does your anxiety manifest or express itself?
- 6. What are some ways you see that you don't necessarily trust God to get it "right" with the details of your life? Where are you most concerned with God "going off script" and doing something different than what you have planned?
- 7. Which of the practical reasons not to worry is most helpful to you in this season? Discuss.
- 8. If God provides for the birds and clothes the flowers, what are some possible reasons why he might withhold from you something you want/need?
- 9. What are some ways you default to seeking and building your own personal kingdom? What would it look like, practically, to seek and build God's kingdom instead?
- 10. What one thing will you do with this message this week?
