Questions for Gospel Reflection & Application

- 1. Review: What's something you've been determined to put to death in your life over this past week? How did you go about trying kill it? How did it go?
- 2. What qualities good or bad do you think our culture would say Christians have put on? What are the first and primary attributes they see in the Church?
- 3. What stands out to you most about the list of 7 attitudes we are to put on?
- 4. If there were communities of people in every city who deeply embodied these 7 attitudes, what do you think the rest of society would think of them/us?
- 5. Choose one of these attributes that's most difficult for you. How would a deeper and more Christlike love help you embody that attitude? How would allowing the peace of Christ to play umpire in your heart help you?
- 6. What does the call to forgiveness and forbearance assume? Why is this important to consider when doing life with other Jesus followers?
- 7. Why do you think Christians are called to teach and admonish (warn, counsel, encourage) one another *with singing*? What are some ways music accomplishes these discipleship goals when dialog or lecture falls short?
- 8. In your own words, what is "the expulsive power of a new affection"? How would this help you, practically, in your life right now? What's something specific you will pursue with joy in order to experience this power in you?
- 9. How does a constant attitude of Gospel gratitude help you with this whole pattern of putting off, being renewed in your mind, and putting on?
- 10. What one thing will you do to act on this message?
