## **Questions for Gospel Reflection & Application**

- 1. As you observe the cultural moment happening right now, what would you guess people's minds are fixated on?
- 2. What cause-effect relationships do you observe between those fixations and the outcomes (in terms of attitudes, actions, reactions, etc.)?
- 3. By default, what would you say your mind is fixated on? [What do your thoughts intuitively go back to over and over again, without any conscious effort on your part at all? Honestly, what are you living for?]
- 4. What are some "things above" that you could fix your mind on?
- 5. What are some practical/helpful ways you could shift your thinking from earthly things to the kinds of things you listed under #4 in the course of a typical day? What would it look like to "seek" and to "set your mind on" these kinds of things.
- 6. The Bible says Jesus sits at the right hand of God the Father. What practical relevance does this have to your everyday life? What difference could it have if this became a regular part of your faith and practice?
- 7. How do you tend to view the sins/mistakes/failures of your own past? What would it look like for you to reckon yourself dead in Christ with regard to these things?
- 8. Knowing that you get future glory with Christ by faith, what's one thing you're free to do with your life right now that feels risky?
- 9. What's one practical way you could pursue your identity and/or security in Christ this week? What's one practical way you could fixate on something that's a reflection of his heart?
- 10. What one thing will you do to act on this message?
