Questions for Gospel Reflection & Application

- 1. Who are the 3-5 people who've most influenced your life? What was/is it about them that left the biggest influence on you?
- 2. Who are 3-5 of the "unsung heroes" of your life? [i.e. people who played a critical role in getting you to/through some major accomplishments, but probably didn't get the credit or thanks they deserve] In what ways were your milestones or accomplishments dependent on them?
- 3. Name a relationship where you can clearly see the providence of God. What are some tangible ways you can see God's design/will at work in that partnership?
- 4. What are some of the ultimate prizes of the Christian life and faith? In other words, if you were a mature, healthy follower of Jesus, what would some of your core ambitions be?
- 5. Why do you need partners to help you pursue the things you listed for #4?
- 6. What role does encouragement play in your everyday life? Who encourages you in things that are truly important? Who do you encourage? What does your encouragement look/sound like?
- 7. Who (what kinds of people) do you tend to partner with? Practically, what do these partnerships involve? How do you rely on each other and work together?
- 8. Who are some of the people (or types of people) you tend to overlook or exclude when it comes to Gospel partnerships? Why do you *not* partner with him/her/them? What are some practical ways you could partner together?
- 9. Committed partnerships require lots of grace. Why? Give some specific, practical examples of the kinds of grace you can show to other believers.
