Questions for Gospel Reflection & Application

1. What are some attributes of a good ambassador?
2. What are some things (priorities, ideologies, beliefs, opinions, brands, etc.) you are an instinctive ambassador of? What do you expend your time and effort trying to get others to believe or buy into?
3. Think about how you talk to God about people and talk to people about God. Compare/contrast this list with your answers to #1. What stands out to you? Where do you excel? Where would you like to grow?
4. "We don't pray about the things we think we can handle on our own." Where do you observe this principle at work in your life? What are some things you tend to pray for/about? What sorts of things do you rarely/never pray for/about?
5. What 3-4 adjectives would you choose off the top of your head to describe your prayer life? How do these compare/contrast to those found in this text?
6. What does our culture think it means to be a Christian?
7. How did our culture arrive at the conclusions you listed under #6? How did they come to associate these things with Christianity? How did they come to think this is what Christianity is all about?
8. What has it cost you to share the Gospel? What are some reasons most of us have sacrificed/lost so little in order to share Christ? What do you think are the real reasons you don't share the hope of Jesus more regularly?
9. If you prayed for someone's salvation every day, how might that change the way you interacted with him/her when you had the opportunity?
10. What one thing will you do with this message this week?
